Weather Advisory and Event Cancellation

While the track of Hurricane Joaquin is still uncertain, the entire region is bracing for several inches of rain starting today and continuing through early next week. Moderate to major coastal flooding is now possible through the next several days, along with strong gusty northeast winds. This is in advance of any impacts from Hurricane Joaquin, which may be in our area late Sunday and into Monday and Tuesday.

Please take appropriate steps to remove cars from low-lying areas and secure any outside furniture / objects.

The City asks that those living off of the island do not come into town, as it would put an additional strain on our first responders.

As of this message, there are no evacuations planned. The City can provide short term shelter should you find it necessary. Should you need assistance, please call the Sea Isle City Police Department at (609) 263-4311. In case of an emergency, dial 911.

We will continue to monitor Hurricane Joaquin. Should the storm pose a threat of landfall on or near our shores, we will immediately take appropriate action.

PLEASE NOTE: Sea Isle's annual Harborfest celebration and The Fall Invitational Hockey Tournament, which were scheduled for this weekend, have both been cancelled.
