

Growth Report for Everett

Everett, male, DOB: July 2, 2007, was picked up near the No. 28 of, district, Beijing city on Oct. 21, 2008; at the time he was wearing pink sweater, red woolen underwear, blue cloth shoes, no other belongs. A lot of search for his relatives by the public security department failed to find them. From Oct. 21, 2008 to Nov. 4, 2008 he had been raised in police station of Branch of Beijing City public security bureau, and on Nov. 4, 2008 he was sent to this institute to be adopted by the police station. Since then he has been living in this institute to this day. His name origin: "" is because all of the boys entering the institute in 2008 have the surname "". "" means the hope for that he will have happy life, with an open heart, can take all friends in. His DOB was decided according to his physical state and the complete PE done by doctors for him on admission.

Physical exam results of the child at present: hydrocephalus, facial hemangioma. Now he has been in the institute for more than 3 years and 2 months with the age of 4 years and 6 months. He is extroverted, active and outgoing, has ready smile, every day he will use his smile to welcome his aunts and teachers. He is not afraid of strangers, but he will not speak on his own initiative. When getting familiar he will say hello to you, can speak happily. now he is receiving preschool education, every day his teacher will teach him some new knowledge, although he can not handle them quickly, he works hard to learn, so he is usually praised by teachers. In the mid-autumn gathering in last year, he performs the dance of ye ye wei wo da yue bing, and he is the bandleader of this dance, and praised by others. He is very curious, when seeing his favorite toys, such as: cars he will look at them again and again, and ask all kinds of questions. Although he has hydrocephalus, this does not impact his intelligence and life too much, every day he has class and plays games happily with other children. He likes playing zhao peng you games with other children best, in the games he knows to modestly decline other children,

and he can get along well with other children. He can take good care of himself, he can go to toilet without help, eat, put on clothes alone such simple activities. Sometimes he will help his teacher with something he can do. All teachers and aunts like him very much, and call him Everett.

Everett has a routine life. He gets up at 6:30 and goes to bed at 20:30. He naps for 2 hours at noon every day, about 2 hours each time. He can eat all kinds of foods, but the foods need to be soft; good appetite, moderate food volume, his favorite foods are candies and meat. He can go to sleep alone and deeply without other bad sleeping habits. He has been vaccinated all of the vaccines according to normal immunization program.
