Growth Report on Abandoned Baby BROCK

BROCK, Male, was picked up on Feb. 28 2011. According to appearance, growth development, umbilical cord and defecation, his DOB was estimated as March 11 2010. At that time he was abandoned at Hotel of City. On March 11 2011, after a lot of searches did by Police Detachment of Public Security Bureau of City but failed to his birth parents, he was sent to our institute. Now the proclamation had been expired, our institute is legal guardian for him.

After on admission the doctors in this institute carried PE for him, the states as follow: 46cm in head size, 47cm in chest size, 77cm in height and 10.3kg in weight, a mass sized 5x3cm on sacrococcygeal region, and other development normal. Our staffs named his name, meaning that he will be solid like the mountain and be full of sunlight in his whole life.

On admission BROCK was fostered in the institute. On admission, he misses his home very much, and often cries. Under the excellent care of the caretaker aunt in children's department, he adapts the environment gradually. He has milk twice in daily time, has three meals a day, and has water 2-3 times a day. Every day he sleeps over 13 hours. He is so lovely, and we like him very much.

In April of 2011, he entered into a foster family. Family member is good to him; he integrates into the family gradually, and shares the warmth of a family.

Now he is clever, pretty and lovely; he is active and restless, as well as talkative and has a ready smile. He is adored very much. He is fond of playing outdoor activity and watching TV; he is fond of playing with the ball and small car toys. Now he has routine schedule: get up at 7:00, take a noon nap from 14:00-15:00, and go to bed at 21:00; have three meals every day, and mealtime: 8:00, 12:00 and 18:30; love to have milk powder; kinds of food: porridge, rice, noodle, steamed bun, vegetable, fruits, meat food, fish soup and bone etc. He has average food intake, good appetite and is choosy to food a little; he doesn't like to eat porridge and spicy food. He has sound sleep. Every day he has defecation once or twice and has urinary and fecal incontinence.

Before admission, we are not sure that he has been vaccinated yet. Since admission, because of special physical state, he has not been vaccinated.
