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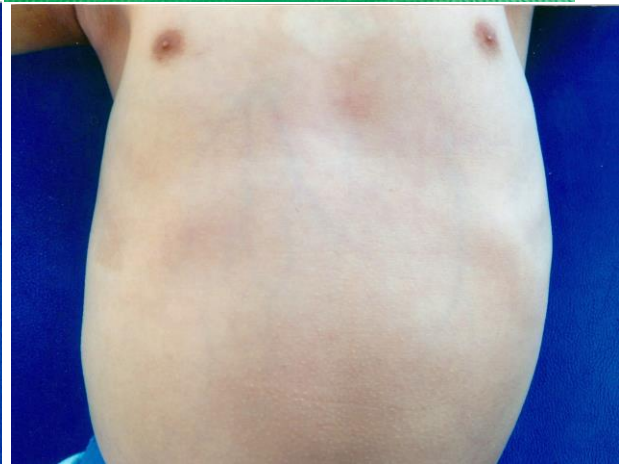

Growth Report for LEVON

LEVON, Male, DOB: Feb. 23, 2010, on March 5, 2010 he was picked up near Neonatal Clinic of the Emergency Building of Children's Hospital. At that time he was wrapped with a cotton quilt with flowers pattern. After a lot of search did by the police department but failed to find his relatives, during March 5, 2010 to March 25, 2010 he was raised by Police Station, Branch of Public Security Bureau, and on March 25, 2010 he was sent to our institute to be raised by Police Station up to today. He has been living in the institute. His name origin: "" is due to all the boys entering the institute in 2013 has the surname "", "" means we hope that he will be a young man who is knowledgeable and polite. His DOB was decided according to his physical development and the overall examination by doctors on admission.

Physical exam result of the child now is cerebral palsy. Now he had lived in the institute over 10 months. He is more than 4 years and 11 months old. He is fairly extroverted and active little man; the aunts and teachers all like him. He gets along well with other children. Now he can make single sound of ma (mom), and also can understand simple instructions and daily words. Now he is accepting the rehabilitation training and the Conductive Education in our institute. Under the patient teaching of the teacher, he can imitate the teacher playing the tambourine and play the rattles. He also can point to his five sense organs. In the perception class, the teacher asks him to put his hand into the basin with warm water, which can make him feel water temperature, as well as make him to learn to wash his hand in the class. The teacher often praise him well done. Now he can walk with hands holding the handrails, though not steadily, he works hard and is strong. In life, he leans to put on and take off shoes, socks and trousers by his own efforts, and can be cooperative when put on and take off clothes, although it is not fast, he is very careful. Usually he likes to play blocks with children together, also likes to play outdoor activity with the aunt and children, then he can play his favorite swing and swivel chair; every time he is playing with children, he is very happy and is immersed in a happy atmosphere totally.

He has routine life, gets up at 6:30, and goes to bed at 20:30, has a noon nap for 2 hours at noon, has three meals a day. He eats all food, has moderate capacity for eating, has good appetite and is not a picky-eater; his favorite food: meat and snacks; he can sleep alone, and has moderate sleep, no bad sleeping habits. He has been vaccinated up to date.
