1. When he was admitted

On Feb.21 2010, police station of public security bureau of County received a report that an abandoned male baby was picked up at the gate of Social Welfare Institute of County. When a lot of search for the abandoned baby's birth parents but failed, he was sent to this institute to be raised upon county agreement of the civil affairs bureau of County on the same day. On admission the medical staff in this institute did PE for him: 53cm in height, 3.5kg in weight, 35cm in head size, 35cm in chest size, red hemangioma sized 4x9cm between the forehead and nose, the reaction of left limbs not flexible. Diagnosis: 1. cerebral palsy; 2. forehead hemangioma. According to the physical growth, his DOB was estimated as Jan.8 2010 and he was named Cai.

Under the excellent care and feeding of the caretakers, Cai has routine living schedule, good physical growth. He has milk well, and is fed nestle milk powder. From the age of 5 months he began to be added some supplementary food q.s., such as minced vegetables, minced fruit, congee, dim sum and bone soup. He likes porridge and milk paste, has sound sleep and normal defecation and urination.

## 2) Body development

Cai's body and intellectual development: compare to peers, his body and intelligence development delayed. He has good appetite and sound sleep; when he feels comfortable, he always smiles, which make you feel that he would be a good baby. But he has his temper in fact, and even obstinate sometimes. For example, he is so picky to the milk container. When drinking milk, when he feels the milk bottle is not his favorite, he would throw it away angrily, till you change his favorite one to him. He looks to have his own feelings; when his feelings are not met, he would cry strongly. He has learnt to crawl, can walk with hands holding onto handrails. He can know his name, knows what "no" mean, can be cooperative while put on clothes; he can respond correctly to simple instructions of the caretaker.

## 3) Language and emotion development

He has poor language ability. When he plays, he would make some guttural sounds, but he can't imitate sounds. He can understand some simple instructions. He is not afraid of strangers, but is fairly attached to his familiar people. He likes playing in the activity room, is fond of listening to music and playing with toys; he enjoys the care of comfort of others. He has a ready smile, gets along with others well and he looks very happy.

## 3. Medical history

Cai has had no severe diseases since admission to this day. Occasionally he has cold, has had fever, running nose and cough at various levels which were cured soon by the treatment of the medical staff in this institute. Sometimes he had gastrointestinal symptoms like vomit and diarrhea which were all treated according to medical advice and the illness was resolved soon. He has no history of drug allergy. In June of 2012 he was diagnosed as 1. cerebral development malformation, 2. red capillary hemangioma on the forehead in People's Hospital of County.

## 4. Immunization

Cai has been vaccinated according to the children's planned immunization program in province.

Now he has been vaccinated with HBV, DPT, OPV, MV, EMV, JEV, and MMR, and has detailed records.
