## Our Work

Whether you have personally experienced parenthood or supported someone who has, you understand what a pivotal—and challenging—time it can be. It's hard enough to navigate this transition for families who are well-supported, but when a woman faces a health, housing or employment crisis, faces language and cultural barriers, or finds herself socially isolated, both she and her baby are at risk.

Since 1997 Open Arms has served over 2,200 low-income women during the critical and vulnerable time surrounding the birth of a new baby, when the impact of being supported is profound, and the costs of being unsupported are equally profound.



Over 80% of our clients are people of color. Many are recent immigrants or refugees. We serve clients in eleven different languages. Most clients face other challenges in addition to poverty, such as social isolation, food scarcity, housing insecurity, postpartum depression and language barriers. Open Arms continually connects our clients to resources in the community to help with these challenges.

In Seattle and King County, communities of color still suffer from disproportionately high rates of infant mortality and adverse birth outcomes. Open Arms exclusively serves women who face these high risks. **Our community-based, culturally appropriate services reduce negative outcomes, while providing the lasting support mothers need to build solid foundations for their children, who can then meet developmental milestones and thrive.**


