Financial Matters + Housing

Admitted freshmen must submit their \$100 tuition deposit and \$75 housing deposit (if applicable) by May 1 (also refundable until May 1). Students should submit their \$100 tuition deposit early, as orientation information is only sent to deposited students beginning in mid-March.

Housing is guaranteed for all incoming students, and assignments are first-come, first-serve. Applying for housing is a two-step process, and both steps are needed to secure a spot in the residence halls:

Submit \$75 housing deposit

Submit housing application

Campus News

In February, we became one of 115 universities in the nation to receive the highest research institution rating, R1, from the Carnegie Classification of Institutions of Higher Education. UWM joins the ranks of other top doctoral research universities such as Yale, University of Michigan, Duke, UW-Madison and Harvard.

UWM physicists and students, as part of an international consortium of 70 institutions and hundreds of researchers, contributed to the search for gravitational waves, along with the analytical tools that identified the detected wave as the product of colliding black holes. This is the first physical evidence of a phenomenon Albert Einstein predicted!

UWM was the site for a recent presidential primary debate. UWM's campus was featured in television coverage throughout the debate. PBS stayed on for the remainder of the week, using the university setting for the news programs Washington Week and PBS News Hour. Students were able to actively learn and engage in their field through this once-in-a-lifetime opportunity.

We implemented a B.S.E. in Biomedical Engineering, through the College of Engineering and Applied Science. Students are enrolling now.

Financial Aid and Scholarships

March 15 is the priority filing date for the FAFSA. Award packages will be available at the end of March via the student's on-line Titan Web account. Students may still apply for some scholarships. Deadlines vary. <http://admissions.uwosh.edu/scholarships/>

Keep in mind that Academic Excellence Scholars may receive in addition to the \$2250/year from the State: \$2000-tuition; 50% room/board; \$400 books; \$1500 work opportunity.

Housing is available for all students. Student must sign up on-line and only after securing their Odyssey registration date. In June students will go back into the portal and be able to select not only their residence hall but also their room and their roommate. Residence Life (housing) will communicate directly with the students. They must read their email.
