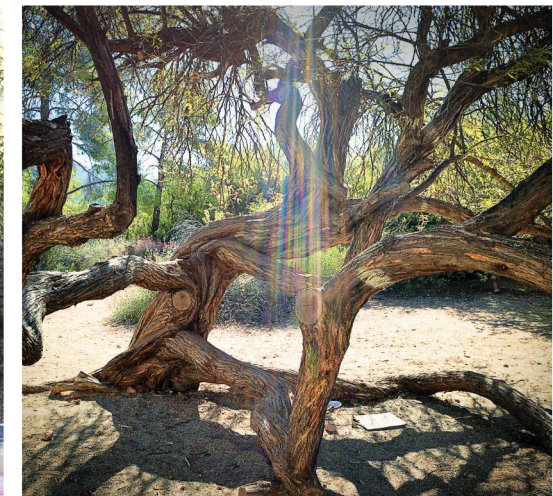

SUSTAIN OUR COMMITMENT TO CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

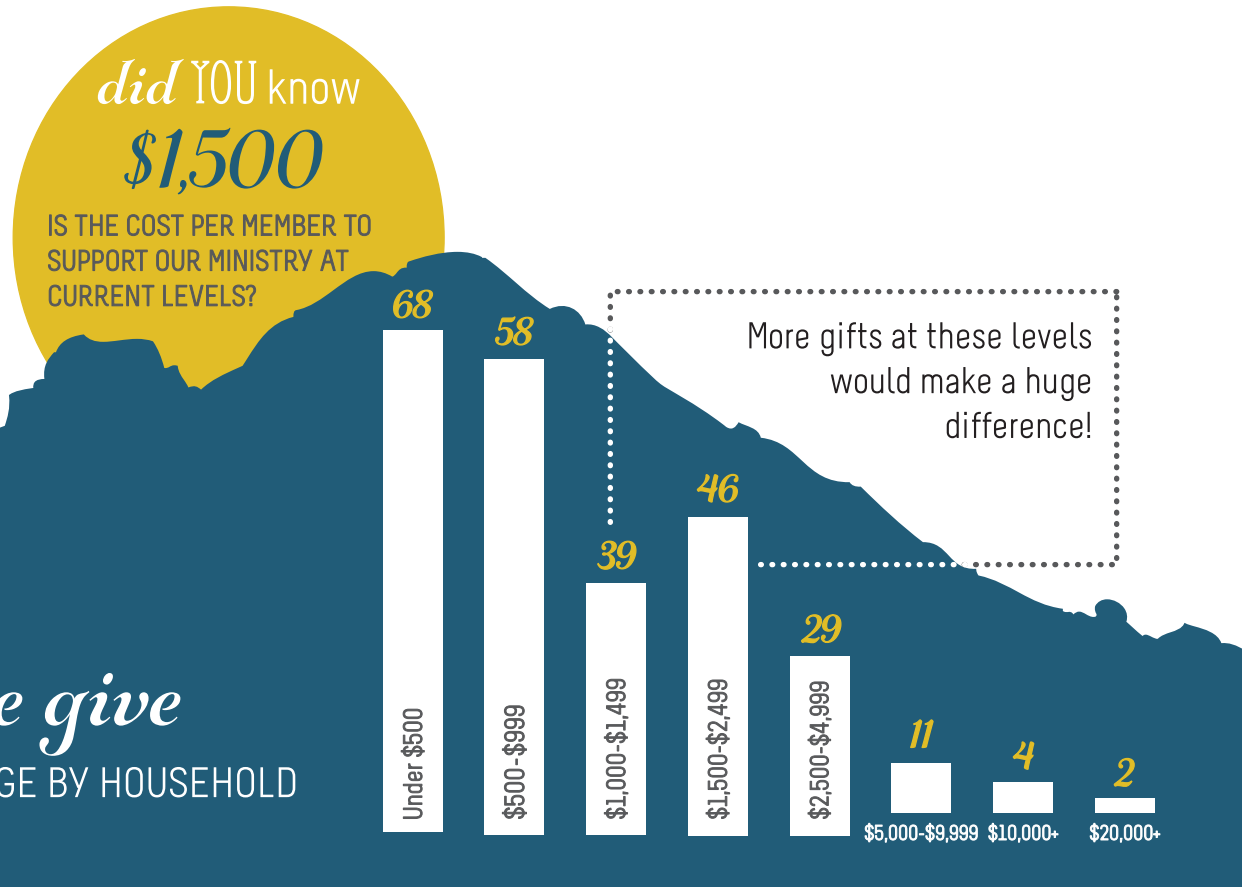
Last year's increased resources to Children's Ministry led to a 15% increase in participation of children and youth. We are seeing the highest attendance since 2012! Let's keep it up!

INCREASE OUR MINISTERIAL CAPACITY

Notice the difference Emrys is making in just one year as our Intern Minister. Funding a second ministry position will allow us to expand pastoral care, justice ministries and diversity of voices in worship.

MODEL FAIR COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS

Paying competitive wages and offering benefits to our dedicated staff is a high priority. A specific goal for next year is to extend pro-rated benefits to all staff who work more than 20 hours per week.

HOW DO WE GET THERE?

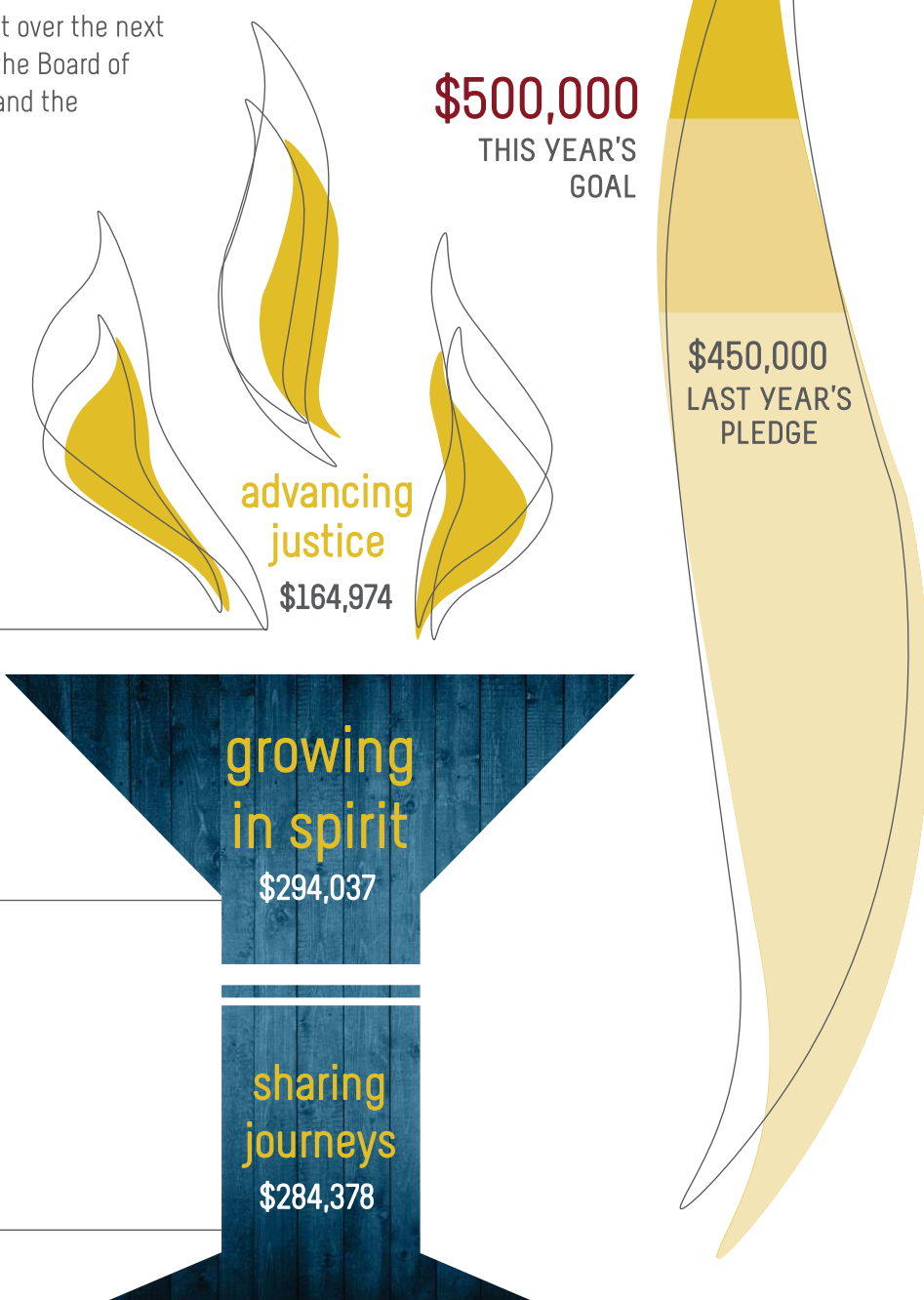
To fully fund our vision would require a 25% increase in pledge income – raising \$575,000 in this campaign. This would be a higher increase than ever before – it simply isn't easy to raise the resources to add a second minister in one year.

Therefore, the goal is to raise as close as we can get to \$500,000 and use funds from next year's Capital Campaign ministry fund to complete the goal. This way, we increase ministries now while we grow into the budget over the next 5 years. This plan is supported by the Board of Trustees, the Finance Committee and the Capital Campaign Committee.
