Border Trip

This is an opportunity to be led by UU Amado members to visit the Mexico/Arizona border to learn firsthand about the immigration crisis.

You may join this trip for either or both days (Friday and Saturday, April 1 & 2.). Cost for one day is \$40, or \$75 for both (scholarship or waivers available on request)

Plans are subject to change, but the general schedule follows:

Day 1 Meet in Green Valley at 8 a.m. We will hike to immigrant desert memorial area (1 ½ mile total), visit Operation Streamline court proceedings, and visit a migrant shelter. UU Amado will provide potluck dinner, then we will have an evening program to learn more about the current immigration situation.

Day 2 Meet at 7:15 a.m. at Amado. Travel to see border wall, cross into Mexico at Nogales and visit migrant dining facility, shelter and memorial for Jose Antonio Elena Rodriguez. Total 2 miles walking. YOU WILL NEED A PASSPORT.

Home hospitality will be offered by UU Amado. You may choose to stay in Green Valley, but would need to make your own arrangements and pay for this.
