**Registration Form:** Please complete and return no later than **March 8<sup>th</sup>** to Mary Wilson, 1034 Harrogate Drive, Knoxville, TN 37923. Registration fee includes Friday dinner, Saturday breakfast, and Saturday cookout. Lunch is on your own. **REGISTRATION FEE IS NONREFUNDABLE**

**REMINDER—DO NOT INCLUDE LODGING FEE IN PAYMENT.**

**Room Reservations:** Room rate is \$142.15 (including tax) based on single/double occupancy. More than 2 guests per room will incur a \$12.50 charge per guest over the age of 12. Complimentary wireless in all rooms and common areas. Rooms located in the Main Lodge.

\*When event registration is received, your name will be placed on a **Rooming List** and submitted to the Waynesville Inn. You **do not** include the lodging fee with your application. **You are responsible for contacting the hotel at 1-800-627-6250 to register and make a deposit to guarantee your reservation. DEADLINE is March 8, 2013.** All unreserved rooms will be released at that time. No guarantee of rooms or group rate after that date.

**Golf Tournament:** The rate is \$55.40 (including tax) per person for 18-hole green fee and cart for Saturday, April 13<sup>th</sup>. Tee times will begin at 9:12am and every 8 minutes after for each foursome.

\***Include the golf fee of \$55.40 on the registration application for each person playing.**

\*Please call the Pro Shop at 828-456-3551, Ext. #326 to schedule any additional tee times other than tournament.

**RAIN POLICY** In the event that rain causes the golf course to be closed during the tournament, you will be given a “Rain Check” to play at the Waynesville Inn during another stay within a 6-month time frame.

**Shopping in Downtown Waynesville:** This is another fun alternative for spending your Saturday.
