Abstracts, of 500 words or less, should be submitted by October 9<sup>th</sup>, 2015 by uploading it to [ITSMN.org](http://ITSMN.org) or emailing it to [info@itsmn.org](mailto:info@itsmn.org). Each submittal should include title, abstract, author contact info, and area(s) covered from the topics of interest above. The presentations are expected to be 15 to 25 minutes in duration and include a brief technology-relevant corporate background, items such as technology description, status, trend, standard, interoperability, and issues/challenges, and a related sample on-going or recently completed project. Selected submittals shall be confirmed to the author at the provided contact info by October 16<sup>th</sup>, 2015.
