Strictly Social Alcohol Policy For Church Sponsored Events

The Board of Trustees shall review and approve/deny any request to consume alcohol within the facilities of First Church using the following guidelines:

Organizers Responsibilities:

1. Observe a high standard of care in serving the public and recognize that the serving and consumption of alcohol require attention to potential risks. Unsafe or unruly behavior will not be permitted.
2. Alcoholic beverages are to be clearly marked as such or served in segregated areas.
3. Non-alcoholic (NA) beverages are to be served with the same level of attractiveness and access as alcoholic beverages.
4. Persons choosing not to drink shall not be made uncomfortable in exercising their preference.
5. The availability of alcoholic beverages shall not be promoted disproportionately.
6. Alcohol shall not be permitted at events at which youth are the focus or are dominant in attendance.
7. Abide by state and local statutes regarding licensing/permits and service of alcohol.
8. BYOB (bring your own beverage, limited to beer/wine or non-alcoholic) events shall be permitted, following the guidelines above.
