Nationally it has been promoted by United Technologies
Corporation (UTC) and locally also with assistance from the Connecticut Business and Industry
Association (CBIA)



The stated goal is to focus on cleaning up and making more "green" the school itself. However under the leadership of Mr. David Mangus the Engineering Teacher and Mr. Michael Maziarz the principal, the scope of the efforts has expanded to include parts of the three surrounding neighborhoods, Asylum Hill, Parkville and Frog Hollow. When you have more than 170 students show up along with at least another 30 volunteers, you have to keep them all busy.



There were a total of 13 different projects that the students were able to choose from. Aside from the 4 areas of litter cleanup, there were 3 different opportunities to work in

gardens on the campus, a playground on S. Marshall St that kept more than a dozen students and half a dozen adults busy all morning; a chance to build composting bins from recycled pallets; or build cubbies for the Little Owls Daycare on campus; and two different crews working on the E-waste collection from the school and the community, (eleven pallets worth of obsolete computers, monitors etc.)
