



Call for Technical Papers - Biofuels

Founded in 1984, the Canadian Renewable Fuels Association (CRFA) works to promote and advance the use of renewable fuels for transportation – to protect our environment by reducing harmful emissions and to grow our economy by creating the good, green-energy jobs of the future.

The Canadian Renewable Fuels Summit (CRFS) is the premiere national conference for liquid renewable transportation fuels in Canada.

The 10th Annual CRFS will be held December 2-4, 2013 at the Centre Sheraton Hotel in Montreal, QC.

For the first time, the CRFA is inviting submissions for technical papers describing original and unpublished research and materials. We have invited professors from two of Canada's leading universities to review, discuss and select the winning presentation. The top three paper submissions will be invited to Montreal to present their papers. The winning author will be recognized during the Green Fuel Awards ceremony on December 4th.

Paper Requirements

Papers must be submitted (and presented):

- Must not exceed 10 pages in length (excluding including title page, biography, executive summary and references)
- 1.5 line spacing, 12 point font, 1 inch margins
- MSWord format
- Papers may include up to 4 tables or figures (as part of the 10 page limit) which should be embedded into the body of the document, rather than appended at the end of the document.

Biographies will be used to produce an introduction to each accepted speaker during the session, and may be published.
