Important information about the Choose Your Own Contractor Program

The NYC Build It Back Repair - Choose Your Own Contractor (CYOC) Program allows NYC homeowners affected by Hurricane Sandy to select the contractor of their choice to perform a variety of home repairs. Contractors will need to meet eligibility requirements to participate and must:

- Be selected by a qualifying homeowner to perform repairs
- Have current Home Improvement Contractor and Salesperson licenses from NYC DCA
- Have the experience and resources to perform or subcontract ALL of the work in the program (including structural elements, interior finishes, utility and service equipment, and environmental remediation)
- Have a satisfactory record of business integrity with New York City DCA, DOI, and DOB
- Comply to the program terms, specifications, and pre-determined unit prices
- Obtain at least \$50,000 in bonding
- Obtain at least \$2,000,000 in Commercial General Liability insurance and \$500,000 in Automobile insurance
