Equipping 39 youth leaders and graduated 14 Eagle Leaders in Entebbe, Uganda JFYM Forum

February 28, 2015 my wife and I led a JFYM Forum in Entebbe, Uganda. Though exhausted when we finished, we equipped 39 youth leaders, and we graduated 14 Eagle Leaders who will train others. This was no small thing in Entebbe.

My wife led us through the Going Deeper with Christ and Praying with a Passion sessions. We took some time in prayer and soul-searching. In sincerity we all acknowledged that the majority of us are worse than the youths we lead. All those in attendance were of one mind that we needed to go deeper with Christ if we shall be able to love the youths, to see them with the eyes of Christ, and to help them wade through and out of the mucky waters of this world.

Often in Uganda young people stand condemned, judged and sentenced without a hearing. In Jesus-Focused Youth Ministry many discovered that Jesus does just the opposite. He offers love and grace. One Bwoyogere marveled aloud, "How could I not have seen this all this time when Jesus made it so clear". Yes, JFYM took what was hard to see, and made many things so clear.

One university youth leader, part of the Christian Union, commented: "I pray that all the leadership of the Christian Union be allowed to attend next time a Forum like this is held anywhere in Uganda."

Our hearts flow out to Barry and to all those others who team up with him. Many in Uganda have been made wiser because of you!
