The Rev. Dr. Eric H. F. Law to speak at UC Davis

DAVIS- Founder and executive director of the Kaleidoscope Institute and author, The Rev. Dr. Eric H. F. Law, will be speaking at UC Davis on Thursday, April 9th. The Belfry, the UC Davis Lutheran and Episcopal Campus Ministry, will be hosting Dr. Law as its 2015 St. Augustine Lecturer. This event will be held on campus starting at 7:00 PM in 1150 Hart Hall. This event is free and open to the general public. A free reception will be held immediately after the lecture at The Belfry (216 A Street, Davis) with light refreshments.

Dr. Law is the founder and executive director of the Kaleidoscope Institute, which provides leadership resource and training for building inclusive community, intercultural competency, community transformation, congregation vitality and stewardship. He has been a consultant and trainer for building inclusive community for over 25 years working with the Roman Catholic, Episcopal, United Methodist, Presbyterian, American Baptist, United Church of Christ and Lutheran Churches in the United States, Canada, Asia, Australia and Europe. Dr. Law is the author of 7 books: *The Wolf Shall Dwell with the Lamb* (also available in Spanish), *The Bush Was Blazing But Not Consumed*, *Inclusion: Making Room for Grace*, *Sacred*

Acts, Holy Change, The Word at the Crossing, Finding Intimacy in a World of Fears and *Holy Currencies*. He is an Episcopal priest, a composer of church music, a photographer and a playwright.
