

# SPRING CAMP IS HERE!!



SDFAS is offering a Spring Break Camp, April 16-24<sup>th</sup> from 8:30 a.m.-4 p.m. Half days are available from 8:30 a.m.-12 p.m. We do not offer hot lunch during our vacation breaks. If necessary, you can leave your children until 5 p.m. (There will be a charge of \$10 for that extra hour per day.) Late pick up will be charged 1\$/min after 4 or 5 p.m. We remind you that Spring Camp is offered to the PK0 students. Please choose from these camps below, you can register directly online at or you can fill out the registration form and attach payment to reserve your spot before April 10<sup>th</sup>; first-come, first-served. If cancellation occurs on or before April 10<sup>th</sup> we will retain a \$50 cancellation fee per child. If cancellation takes place on or after April 13<sup>th</sup>, there will be no refund. We reserve the right to cancel the camp if a minimum of 6 children is not met; we reserve the right to combine camps if registration doesn't meet the minimum. An email confirmation will be sent to parents of all registered students by Tuesday, April 14<sup>th</sup>. If you register after April 14<sup>th</sup> a \$50 late registration fee will be added.

## Pre-elementary Camps:

- Explore the Ocean, Science & Art Camp with Rachele (Assistant Christine) for PK0 & PK1, taught in English (P5 classroom) 8:30-4 p.m. Come join us as we take a trip into our ocean waters. We will learn and explore what kinds of animals live in our oceans; read stories and make fun art projects. This camp will be fun for those who love water, underwater creatures and science.
- "C'est le printemps" with Vesna (Assistant Nohemi) for PK2-K, taught in French (P3 classroom) 8:30-4 p.m. Spring's here! Let's celebrate it with paint, crafts, baking and singing. It's all about flowers, nature, eating good cookies and being happy under the San Diego sun...

## 1<sup>st</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Camps:

- Journaling Making and Sketching: with Gabriela, 1<sup>st</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>. Language: English 8:30 a.m.-12 p.m.  
This camp will combine a vast array of materials and techniques to create unique, expressive and beautiful works of art. Techniques will include collage, stamps and stencils, tracing, printing and making textures to name a few. We will work with acrylics, inks, colors, fabrics and papers. Adding papers, we will compose a collage with sewing details. Each project will be approached in an individual manner. Learn to make your own journal: do a collage and paint the cover, bind pages and glue. Drawing and painting techniques will be taught to use in our own handmade journals. This camp is a "morning only" camp. If you need a full day camp, your child can join "Les olympiades" in the afternoon.
- "Les olympiades" with Emilie for 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> grade, taught in French (C3 classroom) 8:30-4 p.m. The Olympiad is a competition game with consecutive tests including games, guesses, sports. During the first days we will build our team, create our games and organize a game space. After setting up the teams, we will give names to each team. One thing is for sure, we

will have fun. For this activity, the more children we have, the more fun it will be.

- Robotics: with Robolink Staff, 3<sup>rd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>. Language: English 8:30 a.m.-12 p.m. \$300/5 days or \$420/7 days. Children will learn how to construct dozens of fully functioning, programmable robots. This class is a hands-on and project-based learning class, educational and fun. This class will enhance creativity and problem-solving skills and students will learn about the latest trends in robotics.

- Surf Camp (Surf Diva): K-8<sup>th</sup>. Language: English. 9:30 a.m.-12:30 p.m. La Jolla Surf Camp is San Diego's number one summer surf camp for children! Since 1999 La Jolla Surf Camp has been teaching boys and girls ages 5-13 how to surf in a safe and fun environment. The camp is all about fun activities, ocean and beach awareness and of course surfing. Our camp surf instructors are all C.P.R. and First-Aid trained and ready to teach the basics of surfing and enjoying the ocean. The instructor/student ratio is 1 to 4. The surf camp takes place at La Jolla Shores, a prime San Diego location. We provide your child with rental of a colored La Jolla Surf Camp rash guard and a soft surfboard so that learning is safer. Whether your child is a beginner or has some surfing experience, the small groups allow our surf instructors to provide your child with the proper coaching. No transportation provided. It is recommended to wear a wetsuit; you can buy one or rent one for \$5 per day. We need a minimum of 3 children to be able to start the camp.
