

TAKE VTA TO LEVI'S® STADIUM FOR **SUPER BOWL 50**

VTA will be offering direct light rail service to Levi's® Stadium from select stations for Super Bowl ticket holders. VTA's mobile fare app, *EventTIK*, is the only way to buy your fare to get to Levi's Stadium using VTA on game day.

Plan Ahead - We recommend checking the light rail and bus schedules to plan your trip to the stadium or any SB50 related activities. For trip planning visit vta.org, 511.org, Google Maps, Moovit or Transit App, or call (408) 321-2300. Allow extra time for crowds and added security.

Buy Ahead - Buy your round trip ticket ahead of time-it will save you time and make your return trip easier. VTA's mobile fare app, EventTIK, is the only way to purchase VTA and/or VTA/Caltrain Joint Super Bowl fare to Levi's Stadium for Super Bowl Sunday. 
Think Ahead - Know when the last buses or trains run for the evening. VTA will be providing **SB50 limited-stop service** to Levi's Stadium on "Super Bowl Trains" which only stop at the light rail stations marked with a 🏉 on the map below. These trains can only be accessed by passengers with a Super Bowl 50 game ticket AND a valid Super Bowl 50 VTA Day Pass using VTA's EventTIK mobile fare app.



Game Day Service - Super Bowl Trains coming from Mountain View will arrive at the **Great America** Light Rail Station, right in front of

Levi's Stadium. Super Bowl Trains coming from all other directions, including downtown San Jose, will arrive at the **Lick Mill** Light Rail Station where all Super Bowl attendees will deboard and walk a short distance to Levi's Stadium. After the game, passengers should catch their trains at the same station where they were dropped off.

Light rail passengers not going to the Super Bowl will take alternate bus service between Mountain View and Baypointe stations.



VTA provides light rail, local and express bus service from many areas to Levi's Stadium. For a personalized trip plan, please contact VTA Customer Service at (408) 321-2300. If staying at a local hotel, please note the hotel's address so that we can plan your trip as accurately as possible.

After the game, passengers should catch their trains at the same station where they were dropped off.

Levi's Stadium prohibits all bags, backpacks and other carriers from being brought into the stadium with the following exceptions:

- Approved clear plastic bags (12" x 6" x 12")
- One gallon clear plastic zip lock type bags
- Small clutch bag (the size of an adult hand) (4.5" x 6.5")



VTA's mobile fare app, *EventTIK*, is your ONLY way to ride VTA to Levi's Stadium for Super Bowl 50!



Download the *EventTIK* app by searching VTA *EventTIK* in the Apple App Store or on Google Play or by scanning the QR code to the left. To board a SB50 train or Express Bus 251 to Levi's Stadium on February 7, you must have your *EventTIK* activated AND your Super Bowl 50 ticket.

How does *EventTIK* work?

- 1. Go to "Buy Tickets"
- 2. Select "Super Bowl 50 VTA Day Pass" and # of Tickets
- 3. Enter Payment Details
- 4, Confirmation Received

How do I activate my ticket on the day of the event?

- 1. Go to "My Tickets"
- 2. Press "Activate"
- 3. Show Your Live *EventTIK* & Super Bowl 50 Ticket to VTA Fare Inspectors or Bus Operators
