Volunteer as a literacy tutor with Reading Partners!

Reading Partners is a literacy nonprofit that mobilizes community volunteers to provide one-on-one tutoring to struggling elementary student readers.

No experience is required to volunteer, and they are seeking weekly volunteers (1 hour/week), as well as substitute tutors. Tutors are paired to work with the same student, for one hour per week, and are provided with an easy-to-follow curriculum that includes all of the books, worksheets, and step-by-step lesson plans to teach an effective lesson. Reading Partners also has a staff Site Coordinator who is available to support tutors at all times. Volunteers make an enormous impact: on average, students double their rate of learning while enrolled in the program.

Reading Partners runs programming Monday-Thursday at [25 Silicon Valley schools](#), with available session times running from 9AM - 5PM.
