



American Southwest Credit Union (ASCU), with its seven branches and 70 employees, is headquartered in Sierra Vista, Arizona. It serves 22,000 member/owners in the area and provides quality financial services to consumer and commercial members at the lowest possible cost. The people who work at ASCU live and work in the communities ASCU supports. They strive to build stronger relationships to better understand the needs of their communities.

This cooperative financial institution was chartered in 1955 and, in fact, is one year older than the town of Sierra Vista itself. Loan decisions are made by people you know and local deposits stay in our community and are put to work to help others.

The board, management and staff get involved and support the local community. They volunteer hundreds of hours for service projects, community events and participate in numerous charitable boards including the Sierra Vista Economic Development Foundation, the Legacy Foundation of Southeast Arizona, the Southeastern Arizona Workforce Connection, the Arizona Governor's Workforce Council, Boy Scouts, Rotary, Relay for Life, Launch into Life programs for county schools, Toys for Tots, Community Food Banks, Project Graduation for area high schools, Ft. Huachuca 50, and Christmas with a Cop. Employees also support and participate in a variety of events sponsored by the Chamber of Commerce, including the Festival of Trees, Health & Wellness Fairs, Christmas parades and Business at Twilight functions.





Recently, ASCU contributed both man hours and funds to Buena High School's marching band for new uniforms raising \$11,000 plus contributing an additional \$10,000 match, contributing \$10,000 toward a non-denominational chapel for the Veteran's Cemetery, and sponsoring an annual motorcycle ride within Cochise County to raise funds for the Wounded Warrior Project.

ASCU is proud to have helped build such vibrant, caring and patriotic communities for 60 years and will be celebrating that milestone this year with events at all seven branches in their communities. ASCU is continuing in its tradition of helping members and communities grow toward a more prosperous future.
