Guidelines for all entries:

- 1. You **must** use an 8.5 x11 sheet of WHITE paper.
- 2. All artwork **must** be designed vertically (your paper should be oriented portrait style).
- 3. You MUST include the name of our school: Mark Twain Elementary School.
- 4. The school year must be included: 2015-2016
- 5. You may use colored pencils, crayons, markers, paint, etc. and make sure to use a LOT of color! Fill the page as much as possible (avoid leaving the background white).
- 6. Your submission and all of its elements **must** be your **original creation**.
- 7. **DO NOT** sign the front of your artwork. We must have anonymity during the judging process (all winners will be asked to sign their submissions at a later date).
- 8. Write **your name, grade, and teacher on the BACK**, preferably on the lower right corner. Please write lightly (so it does not show through to the picture) but legibly.
- 9. **DO NOT** fold your paper.
- 10. Please keep in mind that your artwork will not be returned to you.

Please drop your artwork in the submission box labeled "Yearbook Cover Contest" in the front rotunda.

All submissions are due by the end of school on Friday, October 9th.
