REMINDER 2012 ADA Claim Form

Effective with claims received on and after July 25, 2015, the 2012 version of the [ADA Dental Claim Form](#) is required for dental services. Dental services billed on any other version will be returned to the provider. Refer to the ADA Dental Claim Form page on the [ADA](#) website for additional information and instructions regarding field changes. A sample of the 2012 ADA Dental Claim Form and specific instructions are available under the Claims (Sample Forms and Instructions) heading on the [Forms](#) page of the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) website.

KMAP will be enforcing the HIPAA-submission requirements for the 2012 ADA Dental Claim Form. Diagnosis codes must be submitted with Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery CDT codes (D7000s) and Anesthesia CDT codes (D9200s). Claim details billed without a valid ICD diagnosis code for these services will be denied. Diagnosis codes are available for download on the [CDC](#) website. The ADA also included diagnosis code information in Chapter 8 of the CDT 2015 Companion Guide that is available for purchase through the ADA. Currently, ICD-9 diagnosis codes must be used. Effective with dates of service on and after October 1, 2015, ICD-10 diagnosis codes will be required. Dental claims submitted with diagnosis codes are subject to diagnosis validation editing.

Note: The clinical notes in the chart must support the diagnosis code(s) that are listed on the claim form.

At this time, KMAP is accepting the Diagnosis Code List Qualifier which has been added to Field 34. The provider must submit the qualifier and follow the instructions for completing this field appropriately when submitting an ICD diagnosis code.
