Frequently Asked Questions

How do we get there? Come to COA's Riverwest Center at 909 E Garfield Ave by 8:00 AM on the 1st day of camp. A chartered bus leaves at 8:30 AM from COA and returns to the same location at about 6:00 PM on the last day of camp. It is your responsibility to get to and from COA.

What does it cost? Participation is free. A \$200 registration deposit is required. The deposit will be returned within 2 weeks of returning from camp. If any incidentals are incurred, e.g. damage, the deposit will be less those incidentals and will be accompanied by an invoice. The deposit is forfeited if the team fails to show up and participate.

How old should students be to participate? At least 13 years of age by the 1st day of camp. Adults accompanying youth should be at least 19 years of age and should be familiar with and work with the youth they're accompanying.

What should we bring? The following items are always appropriate: clothing that's in season, i.e. coat (winter), poncho (spring), swimsuit (summer), toiletries, sleeping bags, or sheets & blankets, pillow & case.

What we should NOT bring? Expensive clothing, radios, cell phones, fireworks, games, palm pilots, money, jewelry, pagers, candy or food, (except on bus trip there), two-way radios, non-prescription drugs, or weapons.
