Some additional programs at Aurora Family Service

Aurora Family Service provides a wide variety of programs for individuals and families.

Consumer Credit Counseling Service gives families a way out of their financial difficulties without having to claim bankruptcy or continue to pay high interest rates. They provide financial counseling, debt management, debt consolidation, and budgeting.

New Parents Initiative

provides prenatal and postnatal care coordination, home visiting services, parent education, and case management to young women who are struggling with the stressful demands of motherhood.
