Basic Computer Class 4.0 <i>Facilitator: Cheryl Smith</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Participants will be engaged in activities that focus on basic computer atomy and navigation. Participants will create email accounts. Participants will learn how to successfully complete job applications online and attach requested documents. Participants will receive a free computer for successful participation.

Developing Personal Standards <i>Facilitator: Shyrida Townsend</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Participants will be engaged in a verbal exchange that focuses on personal development that promotes healthy relationships that may lead to marriage.

Participants completing this training will be eligible to work in any CBRF upon successful completion of course.
