You can make a real difference on climate change during this critical election time by forming a small team of elders to ask candidates to complete a short questionnaire, and then to follow up and publicize the results.

ECA will provide you with:

With your team, you'll decide on what area to cover, i.e. a Congressional district, a county, a city or section of a city.

We'll have conference calls in which you'll be able to share your ideas and experiences with other teams, and hear about theirs.

You'll have the support and encouragement of other ECA activists throughout this process through regular Conference Calls.
