

**DAVE CSINOS** is founder and president of Faith Forward, an ecumenical organization that brings together children's and youth ministry leaders for collaboration, inspiration, and resourcing toward innovative theology and practice. He is author of *Children's* Ministry in the Way of Jesus (with Ivy Beckwith), Children's *Ministry that Fits*, and editor of *Faith Forward* (with Melvin Bray). He is currently a doctoral candidate at Emmanuel College of Victoria University in the University of Toronto, where his research focuses on children, theology, and intercultural contexts. Dave has served in ministry with youth and children for most of his life, from volunteering

at the local parish he grew up in to serving as a children's pastor in southwestern Ontario.
