

New CPE Offering in Hospice

The Allina CPE Center and Allina Hospice announce the inauguration of Clinical Pastoral Education in our hospice setting! In the fall of 2016 we will begin a “super-extended” CPE internship, lasting 32 weeks, from Oct 3–May 12. This super-extended program includes a time commitment of 15 hours/week consisting of a flexible 10-11 hrs/week of spiritual care with hospice patients and grieving families, and 4 hrs/week of supervised group learning. This internship offers specialized training in clinical pastoral care, emphasizing an experience-reflection model of learning. This invites an effective spiritual care practice that is congruent with who you are as a person and with your theology. Allina Hospice is the largest hospice provider in the region, and is renowned for our quality of care, from the admission process through the 13 months of bereavement follow-up. Interns will experience a clinical setting that involves end-of-life pastoral care with patients and families, exposure to the interdisciplinary hospice team model and approach to care, and care and support to families during their bereavement period after the hospice patient’s death. Driving is part of the work, and mileage will be reimbursed. We welcome applicants for this fall 2016 unit! Preference given to those eligible for Level II CPE, and/or those with significant pastoral experience, though all applications will be considered.
