Each week in February, we will calculate each classroom's progress toward their goal and put these results on the poster outside their classroom so students can monitor their progress.
- Your child is encouraged to seek sponsors. Family members, friends and neighbors can show their support for reading by making a pledge to raise money for the minutes the children read. This money goes directly to the Media Center at Greenwood and is used for grants for teachers. While we would like to raise as much money as possible, in the interest of the children's safety, DO NOT APPROACH UNKNOWN NEIGHBORS/STRANGERS FOR MONEY! Please limit sponsors to family/close friends.
- Children can meet individual and/or class goals.
