Computer science is becoming more and more important in today's world. The Computer Coding League is designed to foster and support students' interests in computing.

Greenwood Computer Coding League: Students involved in the Greenwood Computer Coding League will be participating in guided weekly practices in preparation for monthly meets. Each meet will consist of three sets of programming and algorithmic puzzles, six puzzles in each set. No prior knowledge of computer programming or any programming language is necessary.

Practice and Meet Schedule Details: League will begin on Wednesday, December 9th, 2015 and will conclude on Wednesday, February 24, 2016 (please see schedule included on the student application below). Practices and meets will be from 2:25 to 3:15 in the Media Center. If school is not in session or cancelled for any reason there will be NO league.

Student Pick-up Information: Parents should be prepared to pick students up promptly at 3:15pm in the front parking lot outside of the main entry. Participation is dependent upon reliable transportation home. If you arrive after 3:15 you will need to come into the office to sign your child out.
