School Nurse:

Wayzata Public Schools is looking for a skilled, bachelor's-level registered nurse to fill a part-time licensed school nurse opening. If you hold this credential and are Public Health Nurse-eligible, you will also be eligible for a Licensed School Nurse License through the Minnesota Department of Education.

This is a great opportunity for someone interested in supporting the unique health needs of early childhood through high school-age students. This position directs the work of health paraprofessionals and oversees the general operation of the health offices. Licensed school nurses also have a unique opportunity to support the district's strategic direction of health and well-being. Technology Paraprofessional:

This is an exciting opportunity to help open our new school, Meadow Ridge Elementary. The technology paraprofessional provides support and assistance and trouble-shoots technology in the building in conjunction with the district technology department. This includes but is not limited to: installing, maintaining and trouble-shooting hardware; supporting applications and operating software for teachers; supporting and training building staff on the use of hardware, software and other technology tools; and sharing knowledge of district technology initiatives to building staff.
