
When is it open? Monday-Friday: 8am-5pm

Are there interpreters? All the staff speaks English and Spanish, and telephone interpreters are used for all other languages while you are at the clinic.

What insurance do they take? Medicaid, CHP+, other insurances, and those with no insurance.

What if I don't have insurance? Cost will vary from \$2-10 based on your income (costs less if you have a lower income.) **See the Aurora** Immigrant Welcome Center (contact information below) for more information on how to get insurance.



How do I call them? Call 303-360-6276, then press 2 if you're a new patient there. If you don't speak English, say "Interpreter, Please" to the receptionist that answers, and then say the name of

your language.

Are there interpreters? Yes, telephone interpreters can assist you in setting up clinic visits, and while you are at the clinic. What insurance do they take? Medicaid, CHP+, some other insurances (check with the office to find out) See the Aurora Immigrant Welcome Center (contact information below) for more information on insurance coverage.

What if I don't have insurance? MCPN will work with you no matter what your income or insurance is. No one is turned away. Bringing your last bank account statement or 2 pay stubs, and a letter from a family member or friend talking about your finances may help them as they work with you.

Are there interpreters? Yes, telephone interpreters are used for all languages while you are at the clinic.

What insurance do they take? Medicaid, CHP+, other insurances (except Kaiser), and those with no insurance.

What if I don't have insurance? Cost will vary from \$2-10 based on your income (costs less if you have a lower income.) See the Aurora Immigrant Welcome Center (contact information below) for more information on insurance coverage.

How do I show them I need help with the costs? Just report what your income is (no pay stubs needed)

**What other services do they offer?** These clinics offer medical care and vaccinations, dental care, some food/nutrition help and therapists for students of Kenton, <u>and</u> any younger children in your family.





**How do I call them?** English or Spanish speakers: Call 303-436-4949 to make a clinic appointment


For speakers of Nepali, Arabic, Russian, Amharic, Somali, Burmese, Vietnamese, Tigrinya,

**Are there interpreters?** Yes, telephone interpreters, an in-person Nepali interpreter, and many patient navigators who speak various languages are available to assist you

What insurance do they take? Medicaid, any Denver Health plan, and private insurances (except for Kaiser, Human, and certain Cigna). See the Aurora Immigrant Welcome Center (contact information below) for more information on insurance coverage.

What if I don't have insurance? If you live in Denver County (not Aurora), the cost may vary from \$7-40 based on your income (costs less if you have a lower income.) You would need to work with a specialist at the clinic to figure out if you can do these lower costs, as you have to bring in a few documents proving your address and your income. Call 303-602-2300 to make an appointment with one of these specialists. Make sure you bring a valid ID, proof of your income for the full previous month, and proofs of address for last two months.




