Manifesto 2014 Sauvignon Blanc, North Coast

Silvery straw color. Mild, earthy, musty aromas of dried citrus and hay with a soft, bright, dryish light body and a polished, fast kiwi, melon, and bamboo finish. **\$15/Bottle**

Redtree Chardonnay

This Chardonnay opens with underlying aromas of lime and kiwi fruit and just a touch of French oak. On the palate, the wine is balanced with fresh fruit flavors of peach, pear and apple. **\$11/Bottle**

Chateau Beaulieu Coteaux D'Aix-En-Provence Rose 2015

Established in 1576 by Henri III, Chateau Beaulieu is the largest estate in the Coteaux d'Aix-en-Provence appellation of southeastern France. The vineyards are located in the heart of a dormant volcano, which allows the vines to benefit from the unique composition and diverse range of soils. Composed of Grenache, Syrah and Cabernet Sauvignon, Chateau Beaulieu Rose is an aromatic, fruit-forward wine brimming with bright, summery notes of strawberry, raspberry and wildflowers. **\$18/Bottle**

Colimoro Montepulciano d'Abruzzo DOC

Bursting with aromas of dried cherries accented by a hint of spice. Medium in body, this is a fruit-forward wine balanced by moderate acidity and soft tannins. Aged in large Slavonian oak casks for 6 months, this is an easy-drinking wine best enjoyed young with everyday meals. **\$12/Bottle**

Manifesto 2014 Zinfandel, Lodi

Dark garnet color. Lively, fruity aromas of red plum, toasty vanilla, lingonberry, and cherry jam with a crisp, dry medium body and a warming, delightful, medium-length blackberry, plum, cherry, and vanilla finish with chewy, dusty tannins and heavy oak. Toasty vanilla frames a palate full of red cherry, plum jam and tart blackberries. **\$18/Bottle**
