Crocheted Drawstrings: 74" in length, one row of double crochet, please use double strands of yarn for durability

Sewing Materials: Please bring in your own thread, scissors and pins on the day of the event!

Preparation-Feel like doing some sewing ahead of time? Talk to Cathi Brandon about sewing some pockets to put in the bags before our Bags for Kids day.

Sign-up Sheet for Equipment: Please use the sign-up sheet located at our Information table if you can bring in any of the following for us to use for the day: sewing machines, ironing boards, irons, wooden yardsticks, and big safety pins or diaper pins
