- ❑ **Step 5** – Work with your Participating Contractor to install your qualifying improvements.
- ❑ **Step 6** – If selected, complete a post-installation inspection to ensure the safety and quality of work performed in your home. *If your project is selected for a Quality Control Inspection, you will be contacted by Richard Heath and Associates (RHA) to schedule a program-required inspection prior to receiving your inspection.*
- ❑ **Step 7** – Receive your incentive check and enjoy your comfortable and energy-efficient home!

Your Participating Contractor will help guide you through this process, and will complete all necessary paperwork for you. Your incentive check will arrive approximately four to six weeks after your final paperwork is submitted by your Participating Contractor.
