Session 1: 1:00 - 1:30 PM EAGLE-Net Alliance Overview

A brief overview of the EAGLE-Net Alliance structure and organization, time sensitivity of the NTIA grant build-out, the statewide design considerations and open access component. This will include a discussion of the EAGLE-Net Alliance future with attention to potential middle mile infrastructure upgrades, improvements and new construction.

Session 2: 1:30 – 2:00 PM Open Access Middle Mile

Discussion on public/private partnerships between EAGLE-Net and last mile connection companies/local wired or wireless Internet Service Providers and Mobile Carriers. How an open access middle mile serves as the foundation to help ensure sustainable community growth across Colorado and to push broadband services further out to the rural unserved and underserved regions.

Session 3: 2:00 – 2:30 PM Community Anchor Institutions

EAGLE-Net as an option for public entities. Community anchor institutions named and identified in the grant in addition to community anchor institutions not directly named in the NTIA BTOP2 grant. Clarification on only government entities are eligible to receive EAGLE-Net services directly to their facilities. How local wired or wireless Internet Service Providers also play into delivering last mile connectivity for EAGLE-Net services. Types of entities that cannot receive EAGLE-Net service at their facility, and cannot become EAGLE-Net customers as mandated by Colorado law SB-152.

Session 4: 2:30 – 3:00 PM Regional Build Planning

Regional build planning and local facilities for areas encompassing counties of Moffat and Rio Blanco and their communities. EAGLE-Net points of interconnect (POI), local network aggregation points and potential carrier neutral locations. Discussion of the present and future broadband needs of this area and opportunities to improve and or expand infrastructure, capabilities and services. This session will focus on the role the EAGLE-Net Alliance can play in assisting regional broadband development in the near and long-term.
