Move to Amend Meeting in Sudbury

The next meeting of the NorthWest Move to Amend group will be Sunday, March 29, 1:30-3:30 at the Goodnow Library in Sudbury. Money is not free speech and corporations are not people entitled to the guaranteed human rights in the U.S. Constitution. At the moment money dictates what happens in D.C. Our state legislators are on board in large numbers. But we should work to pass the We The People Bill through the Massachusetts legislature. Four states have so far passed a call for this plus a call for an amendment convention and NH has passed the call through the NH house. The momentum is increasing.
