ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE PROCEDURES

BEFORE SCHOOL: All students should go directly to the playground in the morning. As adequate supervision is **not** available until 7:00am, we ask that students do not arrive at school before that time.

BY CAR: Use the drive thru drop off/pick up lane in the morning and afternoon. As you enter the parking lot, make an immediate right (2nd-8th grade) or left (K-1st) turn into the drive thru lane. Pull forward as far as you can and make sure that your car has come to a complete stop before your child exits the vehicle. If you wish to escort your child to the main building, please park in a designated parking space in the NORTHWEST parking lot. The EAST parking lot is for staff parking only.

A quick note about driving: we strive to be "good neighbors" to our friends on 34th Street and on Highland Avenue. Please be aware that parking on the north side of Highland Avenue is not allowed at any time and to be mindful of driveways along 34th Street. Our parking lot is busy and a little bit of courtesy goes a long way!

<u>WALKING</u>: Students are able to enter the campus from the front and back gates. Campus gates are open before school from 7:00-7:35am and after school from 3:00-3:15pm. Gates are locked during school hours. We ask that students use the sidewalk on the EAST side of 34th Street. Crossing guards are stationed at both 34th Street & Campbell and at 36th Street & Campbell.

BIKING: We ask that all students wear helmets and follow the bike safety rules. Students should enter the school from the EAST side of 34th street and use the sidewalk to access the bike racks located on the WEST side of the campus next to the basketball courts. Once students are on campus they MUST walk their bikes.

BUSSING: The bus loads and unloads in back of the school. Bus transportation is provided for only those students that live within Biltmore Prep attendance area.

<u>AFTER SCHOOL:</u> Teachers walk their students to the designated pick up area in front of the school. Teachers will dismiss students as parents arrive. Please be sure that the teacher knows you are taking your child. Use the cross walk for safety!

DINING

BREAKFAST: Eating a healthy breakfast is a great way to prepare for a full day of learning. Fortunately, the Creighton School District is able to provide breakfast for all of our students at no cost. Eating at school is optional. However, it is important that children always eat breakfast.

LUNCH: Students may choose to bring their lunch to school or purchase a school lunch. A school breakfast/lunch menu is sent home with students every month. The cost for a school lunch is \$1.25 and the cost of a reduced price lunch is 40ϕ . Also some students may qualify for free lunch. Lunch applications are sent home during the first week of school. Students may pay for their lunch daily or they can pay for several lunches in advance. Cash and check are acceptable forms of payment. Our cafeteria staff will be available to assist you beginning August 2nd if you would like to come in and pay for your child's lunch in advance. Students are assigned a school ID # that they will need to memorize and enter the five-digit ID# on a keypad when they purchase a school lunch.

SNACK: We are also fortunate to participate in a fresh Fruit and Vegetable program that provides healthy snacks to students in the afternoon.


BILTMORE PREP SCHOOL UNIFORMS
