LAS VIRGENES UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT SEEKS VOLUNTEERS FOR GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND – MEASURE G OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

The Board of Education of the Las Virgenes Unified School District is seeking interested volunteers to serve on a citizens' oversight committee for the approved Measure G bond program. This committee is responsible for monitoring and reporting to the Board of Education the allocation and use of funds generated from the community approved General Obligation Bonds.

The Board of Education is looking for representatives from each of the following backgrounds and organizations to serve on this committee:

- A representative who is active in a business organization representing the business community located within the district
- A representative who is active in a senior citizens organization active within the district
- A representative who is a resident in the district who is an active participant in a PFA/C or PTA organization for one of the district's schools and who has a child enrolled in the district
- A community-at-large member representative who is a resident in the district (2 positions open)

The committee typically meets once each quarter and is responsible for making not less than one annual report to the Board of Education relative to the expenditure of Measure G funds.
