MCS 5th Grade Car Pool Ambassador Program Overview

Purpose:

To provide an opportunity to foster leadership as well as servants' hearts for students in 5th grade, while shepherding incoming TK & Kindergarten students as they orient to the morning car pool system at MCS. This position is open to anyone who wishes to apply and meets the requirements.

Requirements:

- 1) Complete and return the Car Pool Ambassador Application by deadline. (Deadline Thursday, May 26th.) This must include your parent's signature.
- 2) As part of the application, student must ask for and receive a teacher recommendation at the bottom of his/her application.

Orientation:

There will be a mandatory orientation for the ambassadors (to be confirmed, but most likely on first day of school during recess).

Service

Opportunities:

Service will take place during morning car pool during the first month of school. Ambassadors will be assigned shifts during morning car pool during this time period. Students will be required to arrive at 7:30 AM to report for duty on their shift days (it is likely that they will have one day per week as their "shift day", but it depends on the amount of students participating.)

Dear Parents,

We are thrilled that your son/daughter would like to serve as a 5th Grade Car Pool Ambassador at Mariners Christian School for the **2016-17** school year! The students would primarily be serving in the first month of school, as our new TK and Kindergarten students orient to the rhythm of car pool in the mornings. Time Commitment

Students who serve as Car Pool Ambassadors will be required to attend a mandatory orientation, most likely on the first day of school during their recess (to be confirmed). They will also be required to arrive to school at 7:30 AM on the days of their assigned car pool shifts (one day per week).
