He graduated in 1997 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Management Information Systems from the University of North Carolina. Jeff worked as an IT Engineer at Grand Valley State University. Prior to that he had worked ten years at Haworth. Over the past ten years, Jeff starred in short movies with close friends and his son, Brendan. The movies were produced and directed by Tom Berdinski. He enjoyed riding his Harley, scuba diving and boating. Jeff became a dive master in 2001 and was a passionate advocate and supporter for Autism, On May 31, 1997 he married Nannette Wambaugh, She survives him along with two children, Brendan and Drew; father Clifford, mother Sandra, brother, Craig (Karla) Bromley, sister, Jeanne Basch-Witham; Grandma Gloria Lang, in laws Garth (Frances) Wambaugh, Nadine (Doug) Thomas, Jeneene (Brad) Evans and Jim (Tara) Wambaugh; with an extended family of aunts, uncles, cousins, nieces, nephews and special friends.
