Andrew Adair is director of music and organist at Toronto's historic Church of St. Mary Magdalene. He previously served as associate director of music at St. James' Cathedral, Toronto, and as assistant organist at the Church of St. Mary Magdalene. At St. James' Cathedral he contributed regularly to the recital series, playing well over 100 programs.

In July 2010 he played the organ for a service of Mattins at St. James' Cathedral which was attended by Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.

Andrew studied organ with Ian Sadler in Stratford and later with John Tuttle, university organist, at the University of Toronto, and has additionally received tuition from a number of international sources.
