

Women in Business Santa Cruz Area Chamber of Commerce 2016-2017 Scholarship Opportunities



Santa Cruz Chamber of Commerce Women in Business invites women to apply for four scholarships that will awarded to Santa Cruz residents planning to attend a college or university in the fall. Two *Women in Business* scholarships of \$1000 each, not dependent on academic achievement, will be awarded to women pursuing a business career: one scholarship will be awarded to a high school senior; and one to a woman entering or re-entering a college, university, or vocational school after a two year break. Two *Cathy Schlumbrecht Cruzin' Courses* Scholarships of \$1000 will be awarded to women for study in any discipline. Application deadline is May 20.

Details of the Women in Business Scholarship Program

Scholarships are awarded at the June 3 Women in Business Luncheon with personal introductions and recognition of each of the award winners. These scholarships are funded entirely from Women in Business Luncheon raffles and from the *Cruzin' Courses* progressive dinner produced annually by Cathy Schlumbrecht, Senior Vice President at Comerica Bank, a committee of Women in Business participants, and the Chamber.

Two Women in Business Scholarships of \$1000.00 each will be awarded. These scholarships give priority to women intending to pursue careers in a business field. One scholarship will be awarded to a female high school senior attending a Santa Cruz County high school that plans to attend a university, college, or vocational school on at least a half-time basis. The second \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a woman with priority given to those entering or re-entering a university, college, or vocational school after a two (2) year or longer break in her education.

Two Cathy Schlumbrecht *Cruzin' Courses* **Scholarships** of \$1000 will be awarded to deserving women for study in 2016-2017 school year in any discipline.

Conditions of Eligibility

- ♦ Applicants must be women who plan to attend university or college during the 2016-2017 school year.
- Applicants must be residents of Santa Cruz County.
- ♦ Applicants who have demonstrated a commitment to achieving their goals will be given priority. High academic achievement is not a condition of eligibility.
- Priority will be given to students enrolling in a Santa Cruz County College or University.

Application Process & Criteria

To apply please:

- 1) Complete the one-page application form available at the bottom of this instruction sheet.
- 2) Attach a short essay (not to exceed 500 words) on your goals and why you feel you should receive a Santa Cruz Chamber of Commerce Women in Business Scholarship.
- 3) Evidence of academic performance (a transcript or other evidence)
