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Surge in Network Participation is All About Value

The Network has seen a strong surge in interest and participation from the provider community this fall. A key reason for this increased interest is that provider participation fees were eliminated as of October 1, 2015, but that is not the whole story according to Beth Scully who joined Arizona Health-e Connection (AzHeC) and The Network as the Senior Manager of Recruitment last month.

Scully, who comes to AzHeC from Reno, Nevada where she worked in a similar role for the statewide health information exchange, HealtHIE Nevada, said that while a low cost of entry is attractive, there is a cost for providers in terms of staff time and commitment. "Providers join because they want and need to share information and coordinate care with other providers and hospitals," she said. "The statewide HIE offers a single connection that can provide information from hospitals and other providers. It's really all about creating a more comprehensive patient record."

Scully said that the value for any one provider grows as more providers come on board, and she said that The Network today has a critical mass of data from hospitals and other providers that is the real driving force behind the surge in participation.
