DPMConnect4Mac now supports downloads from our latest development the 'SpeechAir' smart dictation recorder as well as the latest Mac operating system Mac OS X 10.11 El Capitan.

### [Background information](#)

In the legal and medical environment the Mac platform becomes more and more fashionable.

Many companies already also support the *Bring Your Own Device* policy where end users can decide by themselves which device they would like to use for their daily work.

In many cases this is nowadays a MacBook.

It is therefore quite natural that users expect to download dictations via their Mac into the company network while their assistants are still working with a standard Windows PC.

## INTRODUCTION

DPMConnect4Mac has been redesigned to download DSS and DS2 dictation files on a Mac computer from professional Philips 'DPM' and 'SpeechAir' dictation devices into a company network.

The software allows configuring several download settings such as target folders and automatic subfolder creation.

It is also possible to specify download rules which enable the user to automatically download only specific dictations.

To also support mixed environments, where competitor devices are used, DPMConnect4Mac also supports the download from Olympus DS-5000 and DS-3400 including the used subfolder structure.



## HIGHLIGHTS

### SUPPORT AUTOMATIC DOWNLOADS FROM SPEECHAIR

This release supports automatic downloads from a SpeechAir to a predefined destination folder.

If the 'delete after download' option is enabled DPMConnect4Mac also deletes the corresponding XML file on the SpeechAir that is automatically generated with every new dictation.

### SUPPORT FOR MAC OS 10.11

DPMConnect4Mac 1.4 is tested and released with Mac OSX 10.10. Yosemite and Mac OSX 10.11 El Capitan.
