

GROUP FUNDRAISING IDEAS

Here are just a few examples of some group fundraising activities!

Pot Luck: Have a pot luck luncheon/dinner, in which everyone brings a dish to pass and contributes their recipe toward a company/group cookbook. It costs \$5 to attend the pot luck and another \$5 for anyone who wants to buy a cookbook.

Dress-Down Day: Employees pay \$5 to wear jeans to work on a given day, an additional \$1 to wear sneakers. You hold a little reception to thank participants and a KYC rep will thank donors and explain how funds raised will support our services.

Raffle: Will your company allow you to hold a pay-day 50/50? On payday, sell tickets for \$1, \$5, or \$10. Winner receives 50% of the pot, and the other 50% to donate to KYC.

White Elephant Silent Auction: Everyone brings something they no longer want, but that someone else might really like to own. Items are displayed on a long table with a bid sheet posted in front of each. The donor sets a starting bid for the item he/she brought and others raise the bid by entering their bid on the sheet. Winners go home with items they really like – others get rid of “white elephants” – and money goes into the pot. (This could be on a small scale or a grand scale, or somewhere in between).

Barter Auction: Same as above, but you’ll bid on talents or services (for example, a cooking lesson, a bedtime story for your children, mowing your lawn, teaching you a craft, drawing your portrait, organizing your junk drawer, etc)

Good Ol’ Fashioned Collection Box: Select a week that the company asks for donations from employees, and collections are dropped in a box. On Friday, the money is counted publicly, and the company “matches” that amount. The total goes into the Walk kitty.

After Hours: Bar nights, Karaoke, game nights, bowling/bocce, baggo tournament and wine tastings can bring about some social ways to raise money...or you can **THINK OF YOUR OWN FUN WAY TO RAISE MONEY FOR THE GREAT PROGRAMS THAT KENNETH YOUNG CENTER PROVIDES!**
