## Game Explanations

### **Par 3 Challenge—\$20**

This is both a team and individual contest on the same hole. Conducted on a par 3 hole, there will be 6 different colored landing spots on the green. If the golfer lands their tee shot in one of these spots, they will win the cash prize associated with that color

### **Don't Drink and Drive...Don't Even Putt—\$20**

Long drive contest where talent and strength don't matter! Guaranteed to keep EVERYONE on the same playing field... and keep them laughing.

### **Golf Ball Launcher—\$20**

Players get to shoot their own ball out of our one-of-a-kind creation. Turn a par 4 into a Closest to the Pin Contest.

### **36" String—\$20**

(1 string per foursome) **Note: String may not be used on specialty holes #1,6,10,13,15, 18. You may use only one string in its entirety per foursome throughout the game.** The object is to save a stroke. If all four can't sink the putt, then use the string. If the ball is within the length of the unused portion of the string, then you don't have to count the next stroke. You can move your ball closer to the hole as many times as you like for a total of 36" (length of string). For example, you can use your 36" as you like: 12" 3 times, 36" once, etc. After using length of the string, knot off the used portion to keep track of what you have left.

### **Mulligans**

**\$5 per Mulligan - Note: may not be used on specialty holes #1,6,10,13,15, 18.** A Mulligan can be used in place of a shot. No limit. Purchase as many as you like!
