It is with much excitement that we bring to you this year's **After School Enrichment Program** schedule.

Our After-school / Enrichment program is a great extension of our Award Winning Gordon School and provides cross curricular activities for your children. Our program aims to enhance children's creativity with a wide variety of activities, building skills in critical thinking, listening, memory, visualization, and concentration through singing, hands-on science experiments, physical education games, word puzzles, art projects, and more!

All activities are provided in a safe, nurturing, and stimulating environment; providing educational value infused with fun.

You will notice that there are several changes to the program:

- 1. Enrichment for Day School on Fridays is from 3:00-4:15pm to accommodate new dismissal time.
- 2. **After Care** options are now offered for ECC from 2-4:45pm (4:15pm on Fridays to coincide with Day School's program) **or** 2-5:30pm (Mondays-Fridays). Aftercare for Days School is from 3:30-5:30pm (Mondays-Thursdays) and 3:00-5:30pm (Fridays).
- 3. For your convenience, we also offer **After Enrichment Care** that follows Enrichment classes; ECC's 2 pickup options are at 4:45pm (4:15pm on Friday) or 5:30pm; Day School's pick up time is 5:30pm.
- 4. 'Gordon's Got Talent' with Rabbi Jacobs is now part of our Enrichment program.
- 5. Late pickups will incur \$5 fees for every 15 minutes or fraction thereof

Students who are not picked up on time will be assessed a late pick-up fee based on our afterschool program rates (\$5 for every 15 minutes or fraction thereof).
