*** Equine Clicker Training Session Information**

Topics include:

- Shaping, targeting, classical and operant conditioning, and poisoned cues
- Observation and interpretation of equine body language
- Proper handling of the lead rope to promote safety and ground manners, (*skills which transfer very well to dogs on leash)
- Efficient treat delivery and how to prevent pushy, grabby behavior
- Safe handling and training techniques to maximize veterinary procedures, grooming and farrier visits

Education will be achieved through a mixture of power point lecture, direct observation of horses, group discussion, active skill building AND a lucky few will get to work side by side with Alexandra coaching them as they clicker train a horse.

**** Feline Sessions** with this notation indicate that there is a hands on component. Those who have purchased a hands on opportunity (Lab Fee) will be actively working with a cat/kitten during these sessions. The lab fee covers hands on learning in all 3 marked sessions.
